



TEXAS JOB FAIR STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

To help ensure a pleasant and productive environment for all Job Fair participants, the following guidelines have been established:

1. Must be a current student or alumni of a HACCC University.
2. Professional attire is required for participants. (No jeans, shorts, t-shirts, sneakers or flip flops).
3. Upon registration, all participants will receive an event name badge, which must be worn at all times. If a name badge is lost or damaged, return to the registration table to secure a replacement.
4. Only those seeking employment or career-related information will be allowed into the event. Other visitors must remain outside the event.
5. Please respect the time of all career fair participants (employers, job seekers and staff).
6. For safety reasons, the doorways to the event (inside and out) and the surrounding areas must be kept clear at all times.
7. Participants are expected to cooperate with all reasonable requests made by members of the Houston Area Consortium of Career Centers and all reasonable requests of any person acting in an official capacity as a representative of the host University.
8. University faculty and staff who wish to enter the event must be appropriately attired and must sign-in to receive their event name badge.
9. Houston Area Consortium of Career Centers is not responsible for any personal items that may be lost, stolen or damaged.
10. Houston Area Consortium of Career Centers members make final determination about entrance into event.

By attending the Texas Job Fair, you understand that you are a guest of the Houston Area Consortium of Career Centers and agree that you will follow the Code of Conduct. You also understand that Houston Area Consortium of Career Centers reserves the right to ask guests to leave.
