Texas Southern University (TSU) is a state supported, four-year public institution. Additionally, it is a truly comprehensive Historically Black College and University (HBCU) of higher learning which prides itself on developing urban students into global leaders. Centrally located near downtown Houston, Texas, TSU is characterized by diversity with a multi-ethnic student population of more than 9,000 students representing hundreds of domestic and foreign locales. It was established by the Fiftieth Texas Legislature on March 3, 1947, under the provisions of Senate Bill 140. Since 1947, Texas

academic programs

Texas Southern University is organized into eleven schools and colleges, each with subspecialties and degree granting programs at the undergraduate, graduate, and professional levels. These eleven schools and colleges include the Jesse H. Jones School of Business, College of Education, College of Liberal Arts and Behavioral Sciences, College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences, Barbara Jordan-Mickey Leland School of Public Affairs, College of Science and Technology, Thomas Freeman Honors College, School of Communication, Thurgood Marshall School of Law, Office of Continuing Education, and the Graduate School. Designated a "Special Purpose Institution for Urban Programming," the university measures its success by the impact its graduates have on society.
